

Sovereign Awards Finalist Announced February 1, 2019



The Jockey Club of Canada announced the finalists for the 2018 Sovereign Awards on February 1, 2019. The annual awards ceremony, honouring Canada's Champions and recognizing their outstanding achievements, will be held on Thursday, April 18, 2019 at Chateau Le Jardin in Woodbridge, ON.

The winners of the twelve horse categories and the five human categories will be announced at the 44th Annual Sovereign Awards Ceremony. As well, Gustav Schickedanz and the late William D. Graham will each be honoured with the E.P. Taylor Award of Merit for their life long dedication and remarkable commitment to Thoroughbred Racing and Breeding in Canada.

The finalists, in each of the three media categories, will be announced on or before March 1, 2019 and the winners will also be presented at the Awards ceremony.

One Upgrade for 2019 Announced by the Jockey Club of Canada's Graded Stakes Committee

The Jockey Club of Canada's annual Graded Stakes Committee meeting was held on Wednesday, January 23, 2019. A review of the Graded and Listed Stakes races was conducted by the Committee Chair, Ross McKague and Committee Members, Jim Bannon, Tom Cosgrove, Mark Frostad and the Jockey Club of Canada's Chief Steward R. Glenn Sikura. In addition, the attending race track representatives included Julie Bell (Ontario), Matt Jukich (Alberta), Nichelle Milner (British Columbia) and Paul Ryneveld (Alberta).

The number of Graded Stakes in Canada will increase in 2019 from 45 to 46 with the approval of the Committee to move the Jacques Cartier Stakes from Listed status to GIII. Following the meeting, the Jockey Club of Canada informed each racetrack of any races that will be affected by the loss or gain of Black Type for the upcoming 2019 season.
